

## IPSA Accreditation Fees

Initial Accreditation fees are the same for both the Law Enforcement government agency and private security agency

The following table depicts current initial accreditation fees.

Number of Authorized Full-Time Employees	Lump-Sum Payment
1-50	\$ 10.000
51-100	\$ 15.000
101-500	\$ 20.000
501- 1000	\$ 25.000
1001 - up	\$ 30.000

### Initial Estimated On-site Assessment Charge

In addition to the initial accreditation fees, agencies will be invoiced separately for the *estimated* on-site costs of the initial assessment. Actual on-site costs are impacted by lodging, airfare, the number of assessors utilized, and other factors specifically related to the assessed agency and the geographical area in which it is located.

### Accreditation Agreement Extension and Fees

The initial Law Enforcement Agreement between the agency and IPSA is for 36 months; however most agencies are able to complete self-assessment within a much shorter time. If the agency has not completed self-assessment or scheduled its initial on-site by the end of the 36<sup>th</sup> month of the initial agreement period, the agency may request an annual extension of the Agreement at a cost of 25% the initial accreditation fee in effect.

### Annual Continuation Fees

After an agency receives its initial accreditation award, it enters into a Continuation Agreement and begins paying annual continuation fees, which include the estimated

charge for its next on-site assessment. The following depicts the current estimated Annual Continuation Fees:

Number of Authorized Full-Time Employees	Annual Continuation Fees (includes estimated on-site charge)
1-50	\$ 2.500
51-100	\$ 3.500
101-500	\$ 4.500
501- 1000	\$ 5.500
1001 - up	\$ 6.500

Some agencies may require fees beyond those established and IPSA reserves the right to make special adjustments.
