International Journal of Police Sciences (IJPS) A Quarterly Scientific Periodical - Refereed and Indexed Specialized in Police Science

The International Police Science Association (IPSA – www.ipsa-police.org) is calling for papers to be published in their first-ever issue of the International Journal of Police Sciences (IJPS). The IJPS is a peer-reviewed and refereed international journal for law enforcement, security, research professionals, practitioners, and academics who aim to disseminate and exchange their scientific, police-related research, technical notes, and other scholarly work in policing. The journal is an open access forum to publish scientific research in all aspects of policing, promoting the culture of excellence and quality of police practices, initiatives and community relationships, police research and development, foundation, innovation, and creativity in policing.

The first issue theme is “21st Century Security Issues in Policing.” This can include topics on police reform in the twenty-first century, public order policing and protests, cyber-issues, other financial crimes, rise of the right, post-COVID policing, etc. Papers must be original works not published before. Papers will be chosen to be published in our inaugural issue to be published in 2022. Paper proposals shall be submitted by email to VMarkovic@lewisu.edu by **August 15, 2021**. The submission should include a two-page proposal and an abstract (not exceeding 300 words plus title – *do not submit full papers*). Submissions will be reviewed by the editorial board and decisions will be made by **September 1, 2021**.

Proposals that were accepted will be invited to submit a full paper (5,000-9,000 words), and at that time given style format guide. The final paper shall be submitted by **December 15, 2021**. Acceptance of abstract does not mean that papers will be published. Publication will depend on the quality and timeliness of submissions.
